

Checks will be issued to the students by the Fall 2025 semester, providing that enrollment in Fall 2025 classes is verified.

Applicants must be high school seniors (graduating) or existing college students pursuing a career in the nuclear industry. Applicants must be enrolled full-time, or to be enrolled, in a four-year college or university in the U.S.A.

Note that the ANS-EWS section scholarships for the most part, are restricted to schools in Washington, Idaho and Oregon, exceptions will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Scholarship recipient(s) will be notified by June 30, 2023. However, the scholarship will not be awarded until proof of enrollment in classes for the 2023-2024 school year has been provided.


